

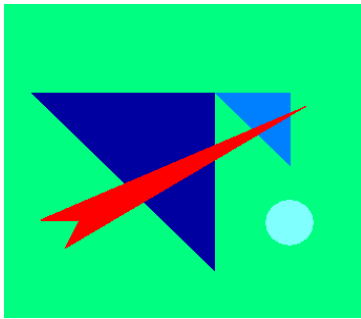

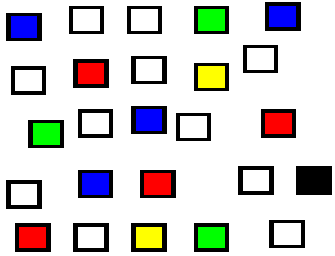

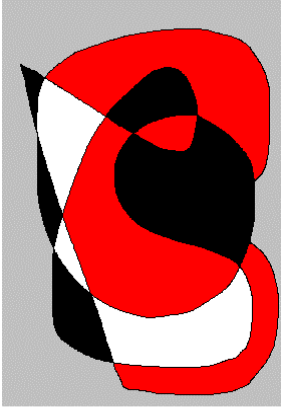
The Illiac IV

- Institute for Advanced Computation
- Predecessor Kim Harris – wire wrap term.
- Wind tunnel humidity/temp control
- Epoxy A TI ECL devices whisker growth
- Looked like a freight train with organ keyboard & large CRT built-in at one end



Illiac IV Cont'd

- Control Unit 200 cards ~2x2' 12 layers
- 64 Processing elements
- Each Processing element 300 4x4" cards in wire-wrap backplane.
- 13MHz (supposed to have been 25MHz)
- ~84MFlop 32-bit floating point
- ~42MFlop 64-bit floating point

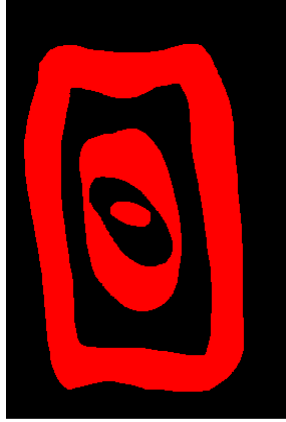

Illiac IV Cont'd

- DZ at helm “finessing machine”
- Large rollup garage door on CU
- IBM cards/belted cable with terminators on PC boards.
- Large insertion levers –major force
- Misalignment causes card align pin to bend or break off
- Saturday removed connector shells used scotch bright. Illiac up for 15 minutes!

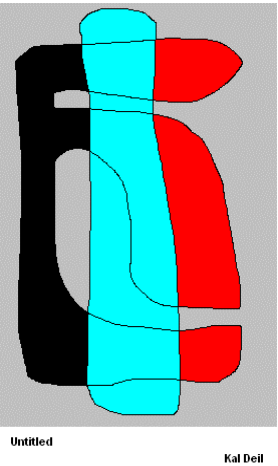

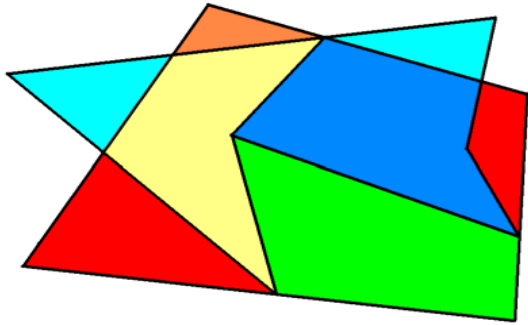
Illiac IV Cont'd

- CU boards covered with wire changes. Tiny coax
- Held down with bathtub caulk, band aids, glue gun, airplane glue, epoxy
- Solder joints were all cold
- 2 months to resolder/ use cyanoacrylate
- Illiac up for 1 hour!



Illiac IV Cont'd

- Since low integration ECL and wirelists on line could compute curves at each point.
- Grease penciled numbered curves on curve tracer scope
- 15 to 25 anomalies on each board
- 2 to 5 real errors
- 200 CU boards
- After corrected Illiac up for 8 hours



The Phoenix

- Dave Stevenson and I assigned to design a replacement for the Illiac IV.
- 740 processing elements (7600 class)
- Each size of small breadbox
- Planar Coax – mostly copper (Bunker Ramo)
- Congress didn't want to spend \$50M
- Good thing!

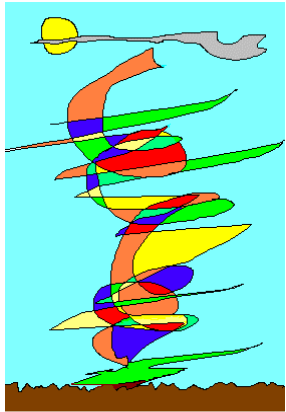

Intergraph and Forth

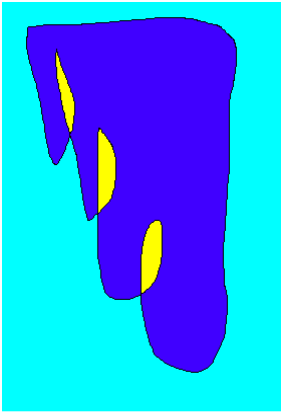
- Intergraph, Sun and Apple using open firmware (Forth)
- I managed Systems Engineering all diags and test programs in C and assembler.
- I had great idea, improve productivity with Forth.
- Programmer ran to Software VP in panic

- Shortly after Intergraph APD sold to SUN.

Forth – Right or Wrong

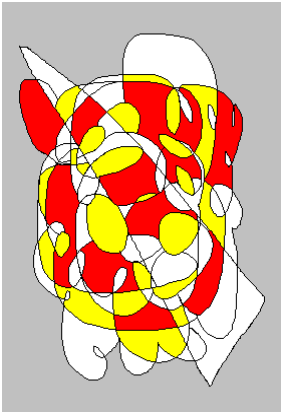
- Common impression – write only

Forth Cont'd

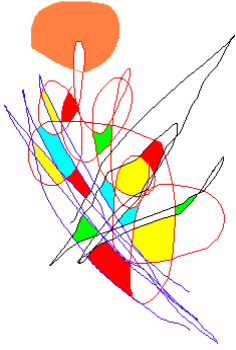


- Flexibility greatest defect
- Cobol vs APL example (Alan Perlis at Yale)
- Easy Writer – major disaster for Forth – never really recovered
- Anarchists love Forth – not best people to show how Forth can be used in a disciplined manner.



Forth Cont'd

- Very little university support
- Other languages have evolved with large libraries of web and commerce stuff.
- Forth has niche in Open Firmware, some hardware bringup, robotics, and a variety of embedded applications. At Apple new hardware checked out with Forth based tools.

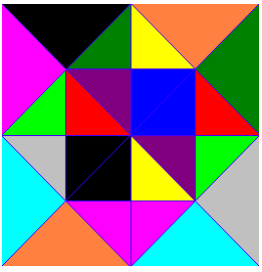

Forther's endangered species?



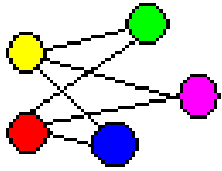


Inner Access Corporation

- Involved in 3 startups

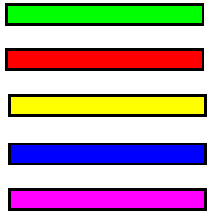
Startups
