10:15 eP32 on LatticeXP2 Brevia Board, Part II --- C. H. Ting

On Forth Day, eP32 on Brevia Board would not restart when the reset button was pressed. The ispLEVER development system from Lattice includes a tool suite REVEAL, which allows one to synthesize a logic analyzer with the core in the FPGA and this internal logic analyzer can be used to trace any internal signal in core. Ting has found that the reset problem was due to a strange behavior of onboard RAM memory, Memory 0 works fine with a reset vector, but memory 1 always returns bogus data. Ting will discuss ispLEVER, REVEAL, and eP32. He will release an evaluation version of eP32 on XP2 to those who have a Brevia Board for testing.
