John Peters has done most of the work on the WinView editor and therefore it will not impact others who work with Win32Forth. He hopes to add to the internal comments and descriptions in the source files. Also he hopes to add comments that do not change the compiled code, but simply illuminate the words that are already there.

Wil Baden is working on a Glossary Generator. The concept as I (John Carpenter) understand it is that it will extract a list of all the words along with the stack comments and maybe other comments and directions from each file and build a list of words called a Glossary. The first pass will undoubtedly uncover words that are not commented and others that may be in need of correction.

Eventually we will end up with excellent documentation.
